CSS Profile Helpful Hints

General/Registration

1. Payment & Submission for the CSS Profile
 - a. Fee Payment code: In early March we sent you the CSS Fee Payment Code. The last step in the process asks for this Code. If you no longer have this Code you may send an email to finaid@vassar.edu and we will resend.
 - b. CSS (School) Code: you will need to enter 2956, which is the CSS Code for Vassar.
2. All other materials (i.e., Parents' Statement of Earnings, Certification of Finances) must be sent to the College Board's IDOC service.

 - ii. SI-110H: 1040 NR –Line 53; 1040 NR-EZ –Line 15
 - iii. SI-125H: 1040 NR –Line 8+13+19; 1040 NR-EZ –Line 3
 - iv. SI-135B: 1040 NR –Line 9a+10a; 1040 NR-EZ –Not Applicable
 - v. SI-160H: use the worksheet provided (for most students this amount is \$0)

 - a. Registration Questions
 - i. Question 8: Not required to, and will not file an income tax return (Skip the next question)
 - ii. Question 9: You do not have to answer this question

 - i. SI-125I: Enter the amount of your earnings in 2015, for most students this will be what you earned at Vassar
