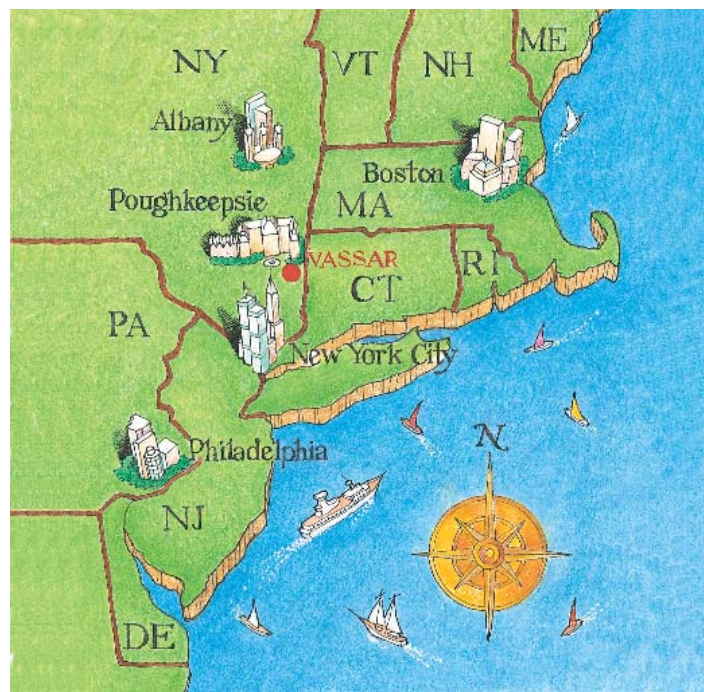


Vassar

Vassar College is located in Poughkeepsie, New York, just two hours north of New York City and a few hours from Boston.



By Car

From the Taconic State Parkway

From the north, exit at Route 44; from the south, exit at Route 55. (The two routes join in Poughkeepsie.) Proceed westward to Van Wagner Road in the Town of Poughkeepsie (9 miles on Route 44; 6 miles on Route 55). Turn left onto Van Wagner Road (which becomes Raymond Avenue) and proceed less than 1 mile to Vassar; a Gothic stone archway, the main entrance, is on the left.

From the New York State Thruway

Use Exit 18 (New Paltz) and proceed east on Route 299 to the end. Turn right onto Route 9W south. Follow Route 44/55 east across the Mid-Hudson (Franklin D. Roosevelt) Bridge. Continue on 44/55 east for approximately 2 miles through the city of Poughkeepsie. Turn right onto Raymond Avenue ("To Route 376") and proceed less than 1 mile to Vassar. A Gothic stone archway, the main entrance, is on the left.

From Route 9 Northbound

Drive 9.5 miles north of the intersection of I-84 and Route 9 to the exit for Spackenkill Road (Route 113). Proceed about 0.5 mile on Spackenkill Road. Turn left at the second traffic light onto Wilbur Boulevard. Turn right when Wilbur ends at Hooker Avenue. Turn left at the first traffic light onto Raymond Avenue and proceed about 0.5 mile. Enter the college through the stone archway on the right.

From Route 9 Southbound

Exit at Spackenkill Road (Route 113) and follow directions above (from Route 9 northbound).

By Bus

Daily service is available from Long Island, northern New Jersey, and Port Authority Bus Terminal in New York City via ShortLine Bus (800.631.8405), as well as connecting service to upstate New York, Boston, and Washington, D.C., via Adirondack and Pine Hill Trailways (800.858.8555).

By Train

Metro-North Commuter Railroad serves the Hudson Valley, connecting New York City (Grand Central Terminal) and Poughkeepsie. For timetables, call 800.METRO.INFO or visit their website: www.mta.nyc.ny.us. Poughkeepsie is also served by Amtrak. For schedules, call 800.872.7245. Taxi service is available from the Poughkeepsie train station (about 3 miles) to campus.

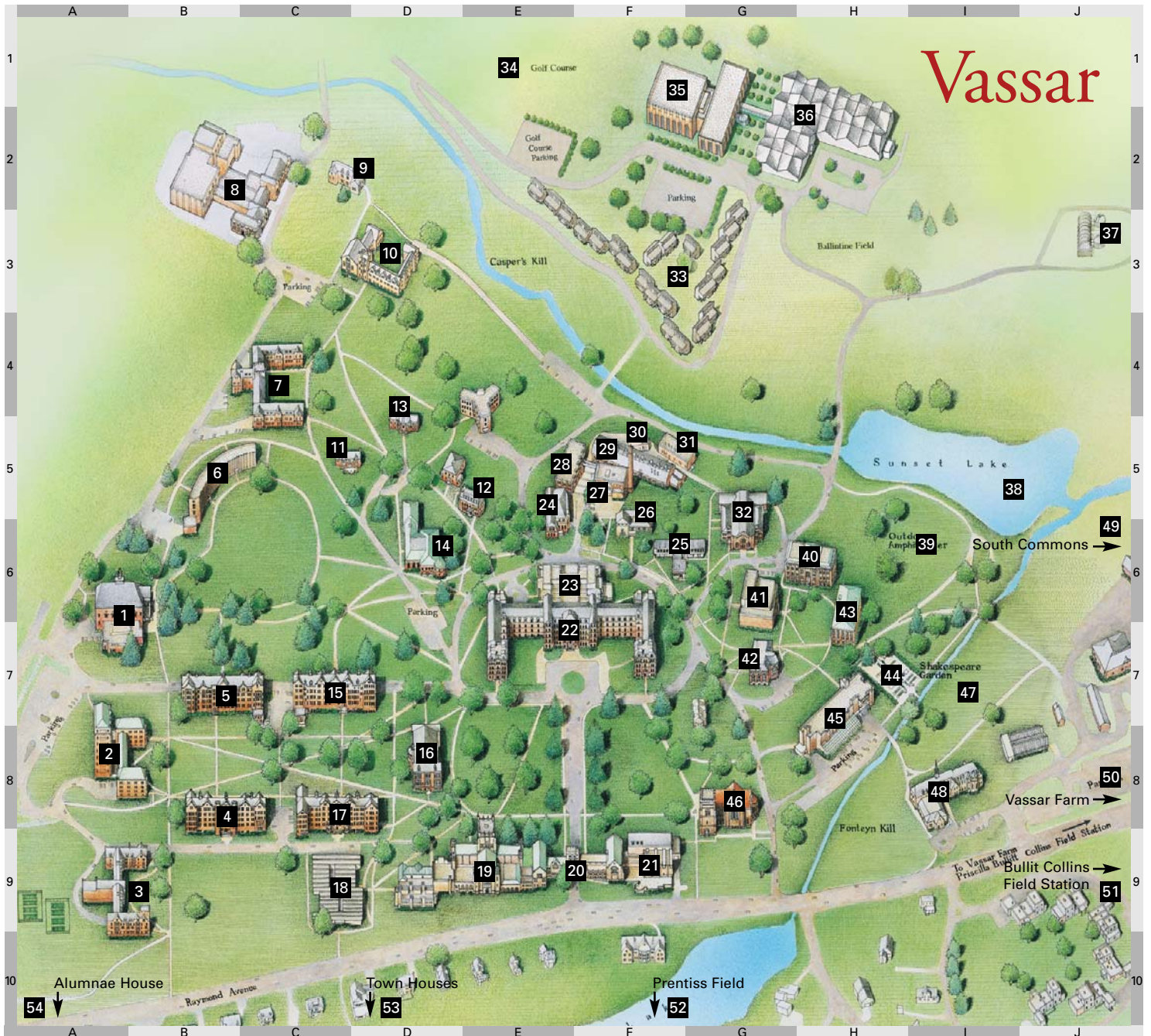
By Plane

Scheduled passenger service is available from Stewart International Airport in Newburgh, New York (about 35 minutes from Poughkeepsie), via American Eagle, Comair/Delta Connection, Northwest Airlines, Southeast Airlines, TransMeridian Airlines, and U.S. Airways Express. Please check with your travel agent or with the airlines about flights into Stewart and ground transportation to Poughkeepsie.
