POLICY ON DRUGS AND ALCOHOL

Vassar College rules and regulations regarding drugs and alcohol comply with Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989. Vassar prides itself on maintaining an environment conducive to achieving the highest levels of learning, and constantly reevaluating the qualities of life on campus. The college's standards of conduct prohibit the unlawful possession, use, and distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol by students and employees on the school's property or as part of any school activity.

The use, possession, and distribution of hallucinogenic drugs, barbiturates, amphetamines, narcotics and certain other drugs are prohibited under local, state and federal law and therefore by college regulations, except on a doctor's prescription.

New York State prohibits the sale or gift of alcoholic beverages to anyone less than 21 years of age or the purchase or possession of alcoholic beverages by anyone less than 21 years of age.

If a prospective student is found to have illegally possessed, distributed, and/or consumed drugs or alcohol while being hosted by Vassar College, Vassar reserves the right to ask for the immediate removal of the student from campus.
